2. Who by him, do believe in God, that raised him up from the dead, and gave him glory; that your faith and hope might be in God (1 Peter 1:21)

3. Behold, the eye of the Lord is upon thee that fear him, upon them that hope in his mercy. (Psalms 33:18)

14. Guide me in your truth and teach me,
for you are God my savior, and my hope is
in you all day long.

(Psalms 25:5 NIV)

15. I will praise you forever for what you
have done; in your name I will hope, for
your name is good. I will praise you in the
presence of your saints.

(Psalms 52:9 NIV)

16. Find rest, O my soul, in God alone; my
hope comes from him.

17. But as for me, I will always have hope;
I will praise you more and more.

21. We have this hope as an anchor for the soul, firm and secure. It enters the inner sanctuary behind the curtain.

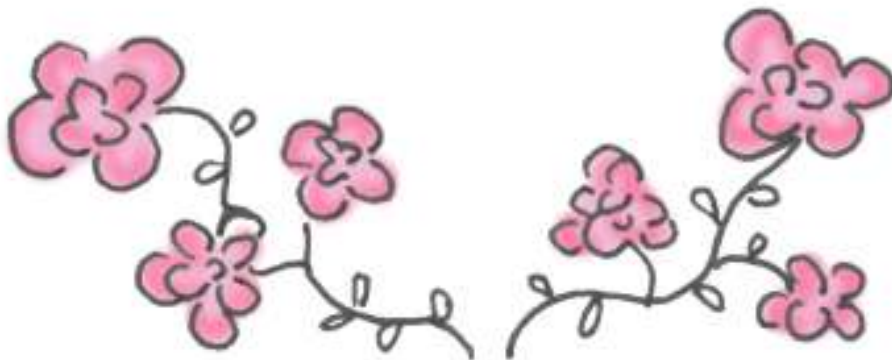

Surely you will hear their cries and comfort them.

26. For you O Lord, are my hope, my trust, O Lord from my youth.
(Psalms 71:5 ESV)

27. When doubts filled my mind, your comfort gave me renewed hope and cheer.
(Psalms 94:19 NLT)

28. I wait for the LORD, my whole being waits, and in his word I put my hope.
(Psalms 130:5 NIV)

29. The unfailing love of the LORD never ends! By his mercies we been kept from complete destruction. Great is his faithfulness; his mercies begin afresh each day. I say to myself, “the LORD is my inheritance; therefore I will have hope in him.”

30. For in this hope we were saved. Now hope that is seen is not hope. For who hopes for what he sees? But if we hope for what we do not see, we wait for it with patience.

(Romans 8:24-25 ESV)

31. Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen.

32. Now may our Lord Jesus Christ himself and God our Father, who loved us and by his grace gave us eternal comfort and a wonderful hope, comfort you and strengthen you in every good thing you do and say.
(2 Thessalonians 2:16-17 NLT)

33. Be strong and take heart, all you who have hope in the LORD.
(Psalms 31:24 NIV)

34. Why, my soul, are you downcast? Why so disturbed within me? Put your hope in God, for I will yet praise him, my savior and my God.
(Psalms 42:5 NIV)

35. Know also that wisdom is like honey for you: If you find it there is a future hope for you, and your hope will not be cut off.
(Proverbs 24:14 NIV)

36. But now faith, hope, and love, abide these three; but the greatest of these is love.
(1 Corinthians 13:13 NASB)

37. The LORD delights in those who fear him, who put their hope in his unfailing love.

38. But since we belong to the day, let us be self-controlled, putting on faith and love as a breastplate, and the hope of salvation a helmet.

40. Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer.
